

## Photography courses from november 2013

Here's a quick breakdown of our photography courses. We've tried to cram everything we know about photography and post-production into 3 weekends, so they're pretty intense! Don't be scared though. We only take 12 students per course, so everyone will get plenty of individual attention, and no-one will be left behind. That's a promise!

### Pre-requisites

- an interest in photography
- a digital SLR with a lens or two (let us know what you've got when you register)
- a basic understanding of how to operate your camera (bring your manual anyway, just in case)

Other things you'll probably want to buy as you progress include a fast prime lens like a 50mm f/1.8, a dedicated flash and a tripod. We're assuming you have a computer to go through your photos on, too.

### Inclusions

- a mix of **theory sessions** (1-2 hours each), **practical sessions** (1 hour each) and extended **hands-on workshops** (otherwise known as "field trips")
- morning and afternoon tea each day (BYO lunch or bring \$10 and we'll organise takeaway)

The cost of each course is **\$199 inc GST**. A deposit of \$50 is due when you register (refundable if your course doesn't proceed), and the balance is due 1 week before your course commences. *A \$50 discount is available if you register for all three courses and pay upfront.*

**Course 1:  
The essentials**  
2 days, up to 12 students

**Topics covered:** an overview of exposure; de-mystifying "M"; aperture; depth of field; metering and white balance; histograms; shutter speed; ISO; filters; light; perspective; composition

**Hands-on workshop:** field trip on day 2 (photographic scavenger hunt)

**Course 2:  
Advanced techniques**  
2 days, up to 12 students

**Topics covered:** de-mystifying flash photography; on-camera flash (1 session); off-camera flash (3 sessions); photographing people (2 sessions)

**Hands-on workshop:** live portrait session on day 2

*Course 1 is a pre-requisite for this course*

**Course 3:  
Adobe Lightroom**  
2 days, up to 6 students

**Topics covered:** digital workflow; colour processing; B&W processing; advanced features; output for web and print

**Hands-on workshop:** we'll process a batch of your own photos together on day 2
